Bankruptcy Institute Medal of Excellence.

Tara also practices insurance defense litigation, focusing on cases involving real property damage; municipal law; and family law, handling divorce, custody, support and equitable distribution matters as well as disputes arising from prenuptial, marital, and postnuptial agreements. Additionally, she is also a certified housing court arbitrator and mediator.
