He has extensive experience representing clients in federal court litigation involving patents, trademarks, copyrights, and trade secrets, as well as in adversarial and post-grant proceedings at the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office (USPTO) involving patents and trademarks. He also has experience with actions at the U.S. International Trade Commission and preparing appeals to the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit.

In addition to his substantial litigation experience, Paul prepares legal analyses and opinions and provides consultation on a broad range of intellectual property issues such as freedom to operate and patent validity. He has also assisted litigants as local counsel in intellectual property cases pending before the Southern District of Ohio.

Outside of his practice, Paul serves as Co-Chair of the Cincinnati Bar Association's Intellectual Property Litigation Committee where he helps lead quarterly meetings and provides annual updates regarding recent developments in intellectual property law. He also serves as an adjunct faculty member at the University of Cincinnati College of Law where he teaches a course on what it is like to be a new associate practicing intellectual property law. And, in 2025, Paul became Chair of the All-Ohio Annual Institute on Intellectual Property, a long-running annual conference attended by hundreds of IP practitioners across the state of Ohio and beyond.
