Rodriguez v. Schindler Elevator Corporation, et. al. – Obtained a defense verdict from a Lake County, Indiana jury after just 20 minutes of deliberations in an elevator case alleging that an elevator

maintenance provider improperly maintained elevator doors.

Brewer v. PACCAR Inc. – Obtained a defense verdict from a Morgan County, Indiana jury in a product liability matter alleging that a glider kit was defectively designed without safety features that would reduce/eliminate the rear blind spot.

Brewer v. PACCAR Inc., 124 N.E.3d 616 (Ind. 2019) – Represented glider kit manufacturer on appeal to the Indiana Supreme Court resulting in extensions of the Indiana Product Liability Act's application to component part manufacturers and applying the learned intermediary doctrine to design defect claims.

Mireles v. Schindler Elevator Corporation, et. al. – Obtained a defense verdict from a Lake County, Indiana jury in an elevator case alleging that an elevator maintenance provider improperly maintained a freight elevator causing a door to strike the plaintiff.

Kirksey v. Schindler Elevator Corporation, et. al. – Obtained a defense verdict from a jury in federal court in Mobile, Alabama in a product liability case alleging that an escalator was defectively designed and contributed to the death of a minor child.

Johnson v. Delello, et. al. – Obtained a defense verdict from a Hamilton County, Indiana jury in a business dispute where a co-owner and former officer of a company claimed that he was improperly terminated by the other owners of the company.

Kelly v. Schindler Elevator Corporation, et. al. – Obtained a defense verdict from a Marion County, Indiana jury in an elevator case in which a hotel patron claimed she tripped due to an elevator that purportedly did not properly level with the floor.

Tutino v. Rohr-Indy Motors, Inc., 127 N.E.3d 438 (Ind. Ct. App. 2019) – Won summary judgment on behalf of an auto dealer who was alleged to have improperly performed airbag recall work resulting in an airbag not deploying during a collision and successfully upheld the lower court's ruling on appeal.
