Real Estate Litigation

- Obtained a temporary restraining order against a seller who improperly terminated a \$26 million purchase-and-sale agreement for several industrial parcels
- Obtained summary judgment on behalf of a New Jersey hospital against a tenant pharmacy regarding the interpretation of a restrictive covenant lease provision
