Genna has been involved in all stages of litigation, including initial case evaluation, discovery, briefing and arguing dispositive motions, pre- and post-trial briefing, and trial.

Genna's commercial practice includes representing individuals and large companies in connection with class action defense, fraud, breach of contract, non-compete, claims under the Federal Claims Act, and actions to obtain discovery in the United States under 28 U.S.C. § 1782 in aid of proceedings abroad.

Genna's product liability practice includes defending Fortune Global 500 companies against claims for personal injury, motor vehicle accidents, and general products liability.

In her white-collar criminal practice, Genna defends clients against various charges including mortgage fraud, the Foreign Agents Registration Act (FARA), interstate stalking, the Anti-Kickback Statute, and RICO. Most significantly, Genna served as second chair in a four-week jury trial in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of New York, as well as assisted a client in successfully obtaining a full and unconditional presidential pardon.

In addition, Genna has experience conducting internal investigations into violations of company policies, as well as violations by the

Department of Justice, the Department of Environmental Protection, and other Government authorities.

Finally, Genna maintains an active pro bono practice.
